4. Preparing and using a comprehensive Care Plan
Grows out of the Annual Wellness visit and the Health Risk Assessment process
 - Preparing the care plan in the Electronic Health Record
 - Reviewing the care plan with the patient and family
 - Promoting use of the care plan by the PCP and by the care manager.
 - Periodic review and update of the care plan. At least annually.
